To be considered for admissions, all applicants must apply to have their official IB results sent directly to SMU by the International Baccalaureate Organisation (IBO). Please approach your school counsellor for more details on this. Please do so early to avoid delay in application processing.

4. Select NUS High School Diploma, regardless of your citizenship.

5. Select International and Other Qualifications, regardless of your citizenship, if you have pre-university qualifications that are not from the list above. Please select this category if you are applying with UK A-Level examinations offered by Cambridge, Edexcel or AQA. If your high school results are not known by the application closing date, you must submit your predicted high school scores for consideration. Tuition Grant

1. For Singapore Citizens: All eligible Singapore Citizens are automatically awarded a Tier A Tuition Grant, which is the highest level of tuition fee subsidy. You are eligible for Tuition Grant if you have not previously completed a course at an equal or higher level than the course you are applying for, for which you have received subsidies or sponsorship from the Government of Singapore.
2. For Singapore Permanent Residents: You may apply for a Tier B Tuition Grant, which will partially cover the costs of tertiary education. If you take up a Tier B Tuition Grant, you will be required to secure employment and serve in a Singapore entity for three years upon graduation. If you do not wish to take up the Tier B Tuition Grant, you will be billed the full fees/unsubsidised fees. As a full fee paying student, you are not eligible for the Tuition Grant, scholarships and/or financial aid administered by the Singapore Ministry of Education (MOE) or the university that you have accepted at any time during the course of study. Full tuition fee-paying students do not need to serve the Tuition Grant obligation to work for a Singapore-based company for three years upon graduation from the university.
3. For International Students: There is a limited number of Tuition Grants available for International Students, and these are awarded on a competitive basis based on merit. You may apply for a Tier C Tuition Grant. If you take up a Tier C Tuition Grant, you will be required to secure employment and serve in a Singapore entity for three years upon graduation. If you do not wish to take up the Tier C Tuition Grant, you will be billed the full fees/unsubsidised fees. As a full fee paying student, you are not eligible for the Tuition Grant, scholarships and/or financial aid administered by the Singapore Ministry of Education (MOE) or the university that you have accepted at any time during the course of study. Full tuition fee-paying students do not need to serve the Tuition Grant obligation to work for a Singapore-based company for three years upon graduation from the university.
