The qualifications listed below are common entry qualifications submitted by applicants. This list is subject to change from time to time. Applicants with qualifications that are not listed below may apply to be considered on a case-by-case basis.

- Australian High School Year 12 (Australia Capital Territory Senior Secondary Certificate, Western Australia Certificate of Education, New South Wales HSC, South Australian Matriculation, South Australia Certificate of Education Stage 2, Queensland Certificate of Education, Victoria Certificate of Education)
- Bangladeshi Higher School Certificate
- Brunei A-Levels (good passes in at least 3 Advanced-Level subjects)
- Canadian Pre-University Qualifications (for eg. Ontario Secondary School Diploma)
- China (PRC) National College Entrance Examination (Gao Kao)
- European Baccalaureate

- German Arbitur
- Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE)
- India Standard 12 (CBSE, ISC, Other State Boards)
- Indonesia SMA UAN (Due to the discontinuation of the National Examinations since 2020, applicants who are currently in their Year 12 of their high school studies or graduated from high school in 2020 would need to submit their Year 10, 11 and 12 examination results)
- UK A-Levels Cambridge, Edexcel A-Levels, Edexcel International A-Level, AQA (good passes in at least 3 Advanced-Level subjects)
- Malaysia STPM/ UEC
- Mauritius Higher School Certificate (good passes in at least 3 Advanced-Level subjects, and 2 Advanced Subsidiary subjects, including General Paper)
- Myanmar High School Examination. Applicants may apply if they are already studying in an established university for at least one year and have appropriate university results to present for consideration
- New Zealand National Certificate of Educational Achievement (NCEA) Level 3
- Philippines High School Diploma with 12 years of high school education. Those with less than 12 years of high school education may apply if they are already studying in an established university for at least one year and have appropriate university results to present for consideration
- South Korea High School/Scholastic Achievement Examination
- Sri Lanka A-Levels (good passes in at least 3 Advanced-Level subjects)
- ROC (Taiwan) Senior High School / University & Colleges Joint Entrance Examination

Foundation Qualifications

Applicants with Foundation qualifications may apply if they are already studying in an established university for at least one year and have appropriate university results to present for consideration. Consideration will be based on the results obtained in both the foundation qualification and the university examinations.
