

Pre-Enrolment Medical Examination for (NSMEN) Admitting in Academic Year 2025

After completion of your Online Matriculation, all matriculated SMU students (both local and international) are required to undergo a **COMPULSORY** medical examination with [The Clinic Group](#) in Singapore prior to the commencement of their studies at SMU. Please refer to the location list of The Clinic Locations & Imaging Centres [here](#).

You need to complete your medical examination period by **31 January 2025**. The medication examination is an important part of the matriculation process.

The cost of SMU Pre-Enrolment Medical Examination will be borne by the students. Payment is to be made at the clinic.

At the Clinic (you may go to any of the clinics by The Clinic Group), please inform the counter staff that you are a SMU student and present them with your NRIC / NS ID or Passport.

Important Notes

1. The Medical Examination covers several areas as such the following:
 - Declaration of Past Medical History
 - Urine Test (Protein + Glucose)
 - Chest X-Ray* (filmless) – *applicable to students who require to complete chest X-ray*
 - Physical Examination (height & weight measurements, systems review)
 - Eye Test (visual acuity & colour vision)
 - Hearing, Pulse Rate & Blood Pressure Reading

At the end of the examination, an **SMU Pre-enrolment Medical Examination report** will be issued directly to the SMU Office of Registrar (refer note 2 below).

*For chest X-ray medical imaging centres, no appointments will be necessary. The Clinic will assign the medical imaging centre based on proximity and will limit the number of medical imaging centres to those with proper safety measures.

2. As part of the **compulsory** attendance of pre-enrolment medical examination with The Clinic Group, your consent for The Clinic to release the medical results directly to the Singapore Management University Office of the Registrar is integral to completing the matriculation process.

3. Appointments for Pre-enrolment Medical Examination
- SMU students should make an appointment for their medical check-up via the following URL: <https://theclinicgroup.com.sg/university-appointments/>
 - The Clinic reserves the right to turn away walk-ins depending on the existing queue and appointments at The Clinic.
 - Students are expected to adhere to their appointment time. Being late for their appointment will result in longer waiting time at The Clinic.
 - Calling The Clinic to reschedule appointments is not allowed. For rescheduling of appointments, please [reply the appointment confirmation email with a request to reschedule.](#)
4. Students are encouraged to make a morning or early afternoon [appointment](#) for check-up so that chest x-ray can be done on the same day.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q1: Is the Pre-enrolment Medical Examination compulsory? How should I go about it?

A1: Yes, it is compulsory for all incoming SMU students. Please note that validity of the medical report is **6 months**. Please refer to [The Clinic Group website](#) for the list of clinics.

Documents required by the clinic:

Singapore Citizen/Singapore PR: **NRIC (11B) or Passport**

Q2: I have already undergone a pre-enrolment checkup with another medical provider. Will it be accepted by SMU?

No, please note that only medical reports from The Clinic Group will be accepted by SMU. If you have undergone a pre-enrolment checkup (less than 6 months) with another medical provider, you are required to bring your medical report to clinics under The Clinic Group to get endorsement by doctor.

Q3: I did my chest X-ray a few months ago (less than 6 months ago). Can I do the rest of the examination (except chest X-ray?)

A3: Yes, you can. Please bring your X-Ray result/film done (less than 6 months ago) to the clinic for endorsement. The fees payable shall be \$29.62 (excluding GST) for the rest of the examination plus endorsement of X-Ray result/Blood Test.
