What is an SMU scholarship?

An SMU scholarship is a recognition of your all-round achievement as a student. More importantly, it is also a validation of your potential for success in the future. Depending on the type of scholarship, it generally covers all or part of your SMU tuition fees, sponsors you on university-related overseas trips and gives you opportunities to participate in leadership and networking events.

Do I have what you're looking for?

SMU looks for individuals who care about their community and who want to make change that matters. If you demonstrate academic excellence, have outstanding leadership qualities and have shown commitment to your community, there's a good chance you're what we're looking for!

Am I eligible to apply?

Hundreds of scholarships are given out to incoming first-year students every year. Do read the requirements and eligibility before applying.

With so many individual scholarships on offer, there's a good chance of scoring one. 1 in 3 students received a scholarship or financial award in 2022.

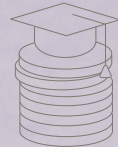

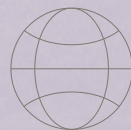

LEE KONG CHIAN SCHOLARS' PROGRAMME

Made possible by a generous gift from the Lee Foundation, the Lee Kong Chian Scholars' Programme is one of SMU's most prestigious scholarships offering high-calibre individuals exciting opportunities for a holistic, intellectual and entrepreneurial development.

Scholars have the option of enrolling in a single degree or double degree programme:

- Scholars in the double degree programme must take Business as one of the two degrees.
- Scholars enrolled in the single degree programme must take a second major - scholars in the Business programme must take a second major offered by the SMU School of Accountancy/School of Economics/School of Computing and Information Systems/Yong Pung How School of Law/School of Social Sciences/College of Integrative Studies, while scholars enrolled in Accountancy/Economics/Information Systems/Computer Science/Computing & Law/Software Engineering/Social Sciences/Law/Deferred Declaration of Degree programmes must take a second major offered by the SMU Lee Kong Chian School of Business.
