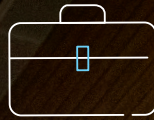

You get to try out different industries to gauge your interest and aptitude before you graduate. All SMU students complete at least 1 ten-week internship before graduation, although many do multiple internships.



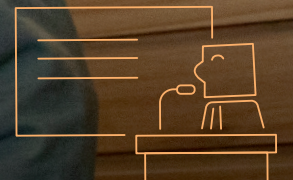

TUITION FEES

Our tuition fees are highly subsidised by the Singapore Government in the form of a Tuition Grant administered by the Ministry of Education. This makes studying at SMU affordable.

Eligible Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents and international students enrolled in full-time undergraduate courses at the autonomous universities may receive the Tuition Grant. Permanent Residents and international students will need to apply for a Tuition Grant as part of their online admission application form. If you are offered a Tuition Grant together with your university place, you will also need to accept the Tuition Grant offer when you accept your place. Successful applicants are required to work for a Singapore entity for three years upon graduation.

Those who are not eligible or choose not to apply for the grant will pay the non-subsidised fees. By paying the non-subsidised fees throughout the course of study, they do not need to serve the 3-year work obligation.

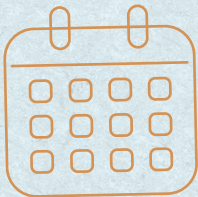


ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS
