A. Fish Tanks at School of Social Sciences and School of Economics

Come up directly from Bencoolen MRT station to view the 'fish tanks' at SMU...beautiful glass-walled study spaces that are hugely popular with students! In fact, we have 5 of such areas in this building: 3 on the Basement 1 level and 2 on the ground floor. Tip: Dhoby Ghaut MRT Station is just a 5-minute walk across the road from here.

B. SMU Campus Green

From the ground floor of the School of Social Sciences and School of Economics, cross the road and walk towards SMU Campus Green. An oasis in the centre of the city, this is a perfect picnic spot with gorgeous views of the National Museum of Singapore and the Singapore Art Museum. You can also bring some snacks and chill out at our stunning alfresco amphitheatre!

C. Li Ka Shing Library

Hop over to the Li Ka Shing Library, located just next to the Campus Green. From the 24/7 Learning Commons to individual study booths, a wide array of study spaces is available for all students. If you have time, you can take the escalator down to SMU Underground where many eateries like Koufu and Kenboru are located. You will also see students dancing or practicing in-line skating here!

D. SMU Connexion Food Hall




